This instruction is a sample of an abstract. You must follow the instructions below for the preparation of your abstract.

Your abstract must be prepared in English in MS Word (preferably) or LATEX (A4 format: 21x29.7 cm, font Times New Roman 12pt, Normal, single line spacing, left margin is equal to 4.0 cm, right margin 4.0 cm, top margin 4.0 cm, bottom margin 5.0 cm). We plan to reproduce abstracts at 70 % of this size [1].

The title, the name(s) of the author(s) and the affiliation(s) with the address(es) should precede the body text of the abstract. The title should be typed in capital letters (Times New Roman 14pt, Normal, centered). The abstract should fit in one page of A4 format.

You may use formulae and references (according to the example of references below). Please, do not include figures, tables and cumbersome equations in the abstract [2].

Abstracts should be presented to the Organizing Committee in electronic form: *.doc (or *.tex) and duplicated as *.pdf files. Names of the files must be: name.doc and name.pdf (or name.tex and name.pdf) where "name" is the last name of the first author, for example: Smith1.doc, Smith2.doc, Smith1.pdf, Smith2.pdf.
